Principals Report: Rob Coumont

• Council was provided with a copy of the Principals report.

- May7-May 24: At home Learning- K-4 Activities both received a blend of paper and digital learning packages. Instruction is provided to the students through Google Meets.
- RDCRS summer reading program- This program has lost funding. The school will be sending home various activities and incentives to have students read over the summer. Some incentives include: @ home activity sheet, Sylvan lake public library programs info, Name entered into a draw for a book.
